With your support, the Friends of the Edgartown Free Public Library raised over \$27,000 last year to bring a wide array of programs to the library that enrich our community throughout the year.

Children's and teen programs supported by the Friends include the popular Summer Reading Program, which enrolled over 400 young readers this summer, and Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, a collaborative program that provides free books monthly to over 50 registered Edgartown children ages five and under. A Dungeons and Dragons program, which became a lifeline during the pandemic for several teens, continues weekly in-person throughout the year with a dedicated group of kids. The Friends also funded the second annual Back to School Supplies Program, which provided free school supplies to any Edgartown student in grades five through eight.

Adult programming this year included a little bit of everything: from learning how to open an oyster to live music concerts using the beautiful Mason and Hamlin piano donated by musician David Crohan, from flower arranging workshops to weekly yoga, from cooking classes to technology workshops. These varied and fun programs provide education, entertainment, community, and culture, and your support helps us to continue offering these wonderful programs for the community.
